# YOUR HOLIDAY

### Arrive Athens

Your Hidden Journey delving into the treasures of Greece begins in its vibrant capital, Athens, which you will have an opportunity to explore after being transferred to your hotel. Kick off your in-depth discovery of what was once the Cradle of Western Civilisation this evening, when you'll meet your Travel Director and travel companions for a Welcome Reception. (WR) Hotel: Radisson Blu Park/Crowne Plaza

## 2 Athens ► Epidaurus ► Nafplion (2 Nights) <sup>4</sup>/<sub>2</sub> We journey to a land of legends this morning. Our leisurely drive takes us to the scenic northeast Peloponnese and past the impressive Corinth Canal that straddles two gulfs. Our first stop is the ancient Theatre of Epidaurus and the Sanctuary of Asclepius, God of Medicine. Spend the rest of

the day exploring the Venetian-inspired seaport of Natplion. **(BB)** Hotel: Amphytrion/Ippoliti/ Grande Bretagne

#### Nafplion > Excursion to Mycenae 0-3

Meandering inland, we visit Mycenae. Stroll through the Lion Gate and Agamemnon's Royal Palace, before seeing the tomb of this fearless Greek leader who commanded the Greeks in their battles against Trojan forces. This afternoon we sample delicious local vintages during a Cultural Insight into wine production in the Nemea region. (BB)

Nafplion > Olympia 0----

Crossing the Peloponnese, we head towards the famous village of Olympia where athletes competed for supremacy in the ancient Olympic Games. This evening we join the Karambellas family on their 30-acre olive and wine farm for traditional Be My Guest experience including dinner and dancing. (BB, BG) Hotel: Amalia/ Europa/Olympic Village

### 5 Olympia ► Amphilochia ► Preveza ► Nikopolis ► Ígoumenitsa ► Corfu (2 Nights) We leave the Peninsula and return to mainland Greece, meandering north past the picturesque village of Amphilochia and Preveza before arriving in Nikopolis to see where the Battle of Actium took place. Boarding a ferry, we cross to the beautiful island of Corfu. **(BB)** Hotel: Cavalieri/Bella Venezia/Corfu Holiday Palace

#### Corfu Sightseeing 💆 6

Begin your day with an orientation tour of the island, followed by a visit to the Venetian Castle and the monastery of Palaiokastritsa. Later, we stop at the Phaeacian-styled Achilleion Palace, built by Elizabeth "Sissi" Empress of Austria and Hungary. Stroll through its Imperial Gardens and enjoy magnificent views of the lush valley and glistening Ionian Sea beyond. (BB)

## 7 Corfu ► Ioannina

We bid farewell to island living on Corfu and sail back to the mainland, continuing to the lively lakeside city of loanning where we spend the rest of the day at leisure. (BB) Hotel: Du Lac/Grand Serai/Frontzou Politia

#### Ioannina 🕨 Metsovo 🕨 Meteora 🕨 Portaria 8 (Mount Pelion)

The delicious flavours of Metsovone cheese and wine provide a fitting start to our day as we arrive in the picturesque mountain town of Metsovo. We continue to Kalambaka and admire the famous byzantine Monasteries of Meteora that stand almost impossibly perched atop colossal boulders. Our final stop before arriving in Portaria, situated on the magnificent Mount Pelion range, is the seaside town of Volos. (BB) Hotel: Despotiko/ Xenia/Pelion Resort

# Portaria 🕨 Thermopylae 🕨 Delphi 🕨 Galaxidi

Traversing the peaks of Parnassos and Giona, we stop in Thermopylae, the site where Leonidas and his 300 Spartans fought bravely against the invading Persians. Join a **Local Specialist** for a guided visit to Delphi. Walk the Sacred Way to the 4<sup>th</sup> century Temple of Apollo and ramble through what remains of this ancient sanctuary which was once the site of the Pythian Games, a precursor of the modern Olympics. The picturesque seaside village of Galaxidi, our home for the night, emerges as our reward for crossing the craggy hinterland to the coast. (BB) Hotel: Nostos/Epavlis/Ganimede

## 10 Galaxidi > Athens O-

We return to cosmopolitan Athens for a day of delving into antiquity, coming face-to-face with the treasures of Ancient Greece. We ascend to the Acropolis and join a Local Specialist for a sightseeing tour with magnificent views of Athena's Parthenon, the Agora, Royal Palace and Temple of Zeus. See Hadrian's Arch and view the stadium where the first modern Olympics took place in 1896. On our final evening together, we join our fellow travellers for a Farewell Dinner to celebrate the millennia and miles explored together on this epic voyage of discovery. (BB, FD) Hotel: Radisson Blu Park/Crowne Plaza

## 11 Depart Athens

We bid farewell to Athens and newfound friends as we prepare to depart Greece, or join the 3-Day Santorini Extension. Airport transfers are available. Conditions apply. (BB)
