DAY 1

WELCOME TO BERLIN.

On arrival at Berlin's Tegel Airport, transfers depart at 10:30 and 12:30.

DAY 2 · RELAXED START THE SPIRIT OF BERLIN.

Travel along Ku'Damm to the Memorial Church, drive through the Tiergarten to see the Reichstag building, continue past Brandenburg Gate and along Unter den Linden, passing the Humboldt University and State Opera to stop on Museum Island. DAY 3 DRESDEN, A BAROQUE PHOENIX ON THE ELBE.

Continue to Dresden and join your Local Expert to see the Frauenkirche, 'The Procession of the Dukes' mosaic, the enormous cathedral, Semper Opera House and Baroque Zwinger Palace. (BB)

DAY 4 MIEVEAL ROTHENBURG.

Venture to Rothenburg-ob-der-Tauber, the best-preserved town on the Romantic Road.

Enjoy a demonstration by an artisan baker and learn about the traditional pastry, Schneeballen (snowball), followed by a tasting.

Spend the rest of the day at your leisure for further exploration.

DAY 5 NUREMBERG AND THE BAVARIAN CAPITAL OF MUNICH.

Travel to Nuremberg, renowned for its medieval architecture, to admire the charming blend of stone and timbered dwellings in the Old Town. See the massive ramparts and perhaps shop for delicious Lebkuchen? Continue across the Danube to reach fun-loving Munich and see the

university, Victory Arch and the Marienplatz, where crowds gather at the Town Hall to watch the antics of the Glockenspiel. (BB)

DAY 6 THE JEWELS OF THE BAVARIAN ALPS.

Travel to Neuschwanstein, a fairy-tale castle spectacularly perched on an Alpine mountainside. With a local historian, visit the exuberantly decorated apartments, including the Throne Room and Lohengrin Grotto. Continue along the Alpine Road to the Wieskirche, a masterpiece of Bavarian Rococo. Venture to Oberammergau, home of the famous Passion Play, and see the immense theatre and colourfully-painted chalets. (BB)

DAY 7 · RELAXED START LINDAU ON LAKE CONSTANCE AND INTO THE BLACK FOREST.

Enjoy a relaxed start before travelling to Lindau, an island situated in the middle of Lake Constance, connected to the mainland by a causeway. Stroll through the narrow streets past old inns and half-timbered houses, to admire the fantastic backdrop of the Swiss and Austrian Alps across the lake. Take a delightful drive into the Black Forest to reach Villingen-Schwenningen.

For dinner you are treated to a delightful Farm-to-Table experience at a local restaurant with locally-sourced ingredients, skillfully prepared and accompanied with wine. (BB) (DW)

DAY 8 THE UNIVERSITY CITY OF HEIDELBERG AND MAINZ.

Travel the German Clock Route and stop to meet locals who still make cuckoo clocks by hand, a tradition passed down over 300 years. Continue through to Heidelberg and venture inside Heidelberg Palace. See the Heidelberg Tun, a 130,000-litre wine vat, spend time in the Apothecary Museum and marvel at the panoramic vistas of Heidelberg and the Neckar Valley from the castle fortress. Your hotel is in the nearby town of Mainz. (BB)

DAY 9 · RELAXED START

CASTLES OF THE RHINE EXPERIENCE.

Begin the day with a relaxing cruise past steep-sided vineyards, half-timbered taverns, hilltop castles and the infamous Lorelei Rock. Alight at Boppard and continue to Koblenz to see the statue of Wilhelm I guarding the junction of the Rhine and Moselle. Enjoy scenic views from the Niederwald Monument.

In the evening, round off your German experience with a farewell Celebration Dinner overlooking the River Rhine, complete with local wine. Prost! (BB) (DW)

Your journey comes to an end after breakfast with departure transfers arriving at Frankfurt airport at 08:00 and 10:00. (BB)
