- 1 Arrive Vancouver**
Welcome to Vancouver. At 6 p.m., gather at the hotel for a Welcome Reception. **(WR)**

- 2 Vancouver ▶ Victoria (2 Nights)**

Transfer to Vancouver International Airport or to Canada Place for those on the optional Alaska cruise. **(FB)**
