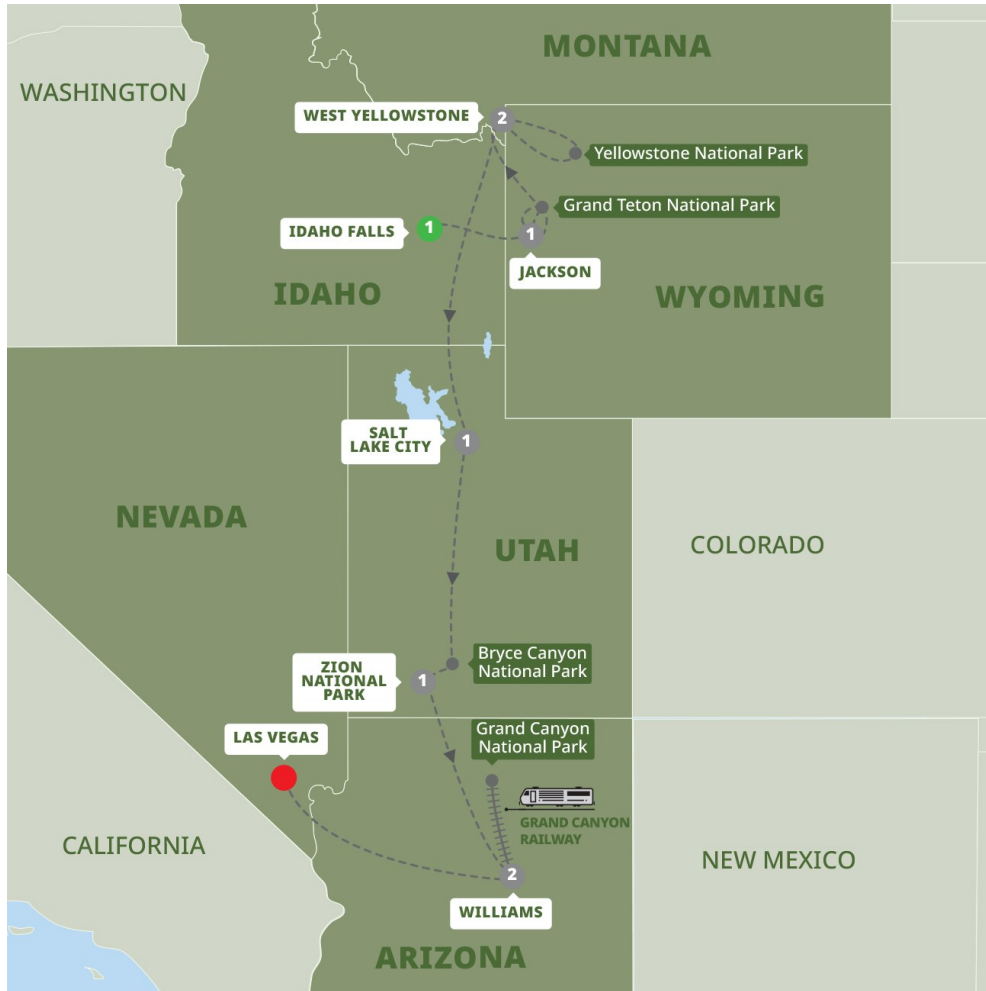

## Day 1
