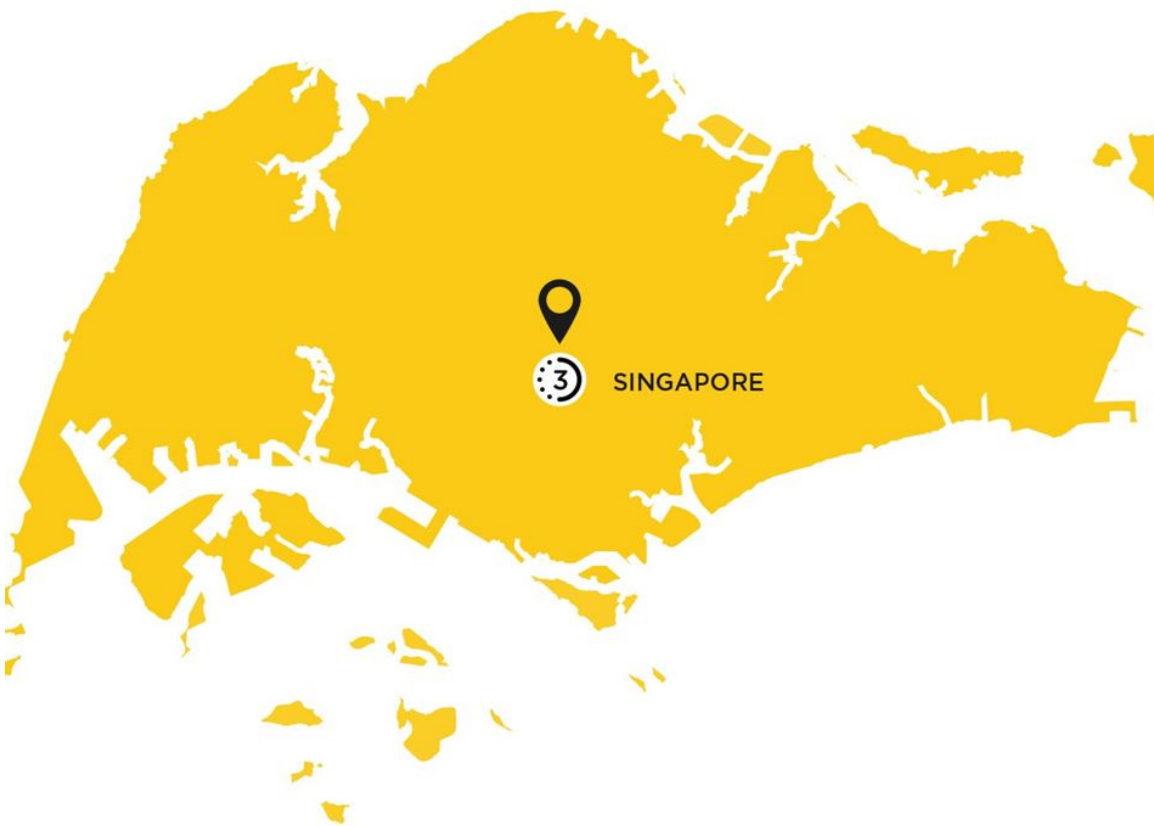

Day 1 | Arrive Singapore (3 Nights)



Welcome to the green, vibrant city of Singapore! A true melting pot of cultures, this is the place where you can eat breakfast in Little India, lunch in Chinatown and dinner overlooking the sublime Marina Bay. All over town Michelin star worthy food is served up in market hawker stalls, while heading just a short distance out of the city will reward you with incredible walking trails, treetop jungle bridges and wildlife aplenty. Arriving today, transfer to your hotel then head out to unearth this multicultural metropolis for yourself.

Day 2 | Singapore Sightseeing



With two days ahead on your Singapore tour package, we'll waste no time and dive right in. Today's sightseeing will kick off at the UNESCO listed Botanic Gardens. Claiming 74 hectares of botanic beauty, the gardens are a lush city oasis of lakes, lawns and themed gardens, a highlight of which is the National Orchid Garden's staggering collection of over 60,000 different orchid species. From here, visit the busy lanes and appetite inducing smells of Little India to experience this bubbly, fun neighbourhood. Next up is Merlion Park, where you'll view the half fish, half lion Merlion statue who proudly stands overlooking the Marina Bay, then travel on to ancient, traditional Chinatown. A blend of old and new, it is a showcase of the rich cultural history of the earlier settlers. Still up for more? Perhaps opt to make a late afternoon visit to the good time island of Sentosa for a snoop around the ultra-modern S.E.A Aquarium. Alternatively, tonight you could choose to take part in an exciting optional night safari, visiting the 40 hectares of jungle close to Singapore from the comfort of an open air tram.

CHOICE OPTIONAL EXPERIENCES:

Late Afternoon Visit to Sentosa - Group trip by coach/cable car - Take the cable car over to Sentosa for a bird's eye view of the Singapore Skyline. Visit one of the world's largest aquarium located in Resorts World Sentosa, S.E.A. Aquarium where you can immerse yourself in a magical marine world. It features more than 100,000 marina animals from over 800 species across 49 habitats, the hammerhead sharks and other gentle giants of the sea. There's no better way to complete a fabulous evening at Sentosa by watching a spectacular night show "Wings of Time", set outdoors with the open sea as a backdrop. Discover an awe-inspiring display of water, laser and fire effects. The return to Singapore will be late evening. The price shown is in Singapore Dollars.

Night out at the Marina - Group trip by coach - The tour starts with a visit to Gardens by the Bay, Singapore's vision of creating a City in a Garden. This multi-award-winning horticultural marvel offers breath-taking waterfront views spanning over 101 hectares of reclaimed land. As dusk falls, the Marina Bay skyline emerges and the iconic tree-like vertical gardens - Supertree Grove, design with large canopies that provide shade in the day, comes alive with a display of light and sound in their Garden Rhapsody Show. Later visit the Marina Sands Skypark Observation Deck and enjoy a

birds-eye view of the city below. It is a roof like no other, perched 200 metres in the air with the observation deck in the clouds. No better way to end the evening than cruising the Singapore River on a bumboat, passing historical bridges and buildings built more than a century ago. The price shown is in Singapore Dollars.

Day 3 | Singapore Free Day



With a day to explore your way, and all of Singapore at your disposal, your choices are endless! High up on your list will likely be a visit to Gardens by the Bay, a \$1.1 billion garden wonderland of glowing trees, soaring domes and even an indoor waterfall. You could live the high life with a Marina Bay Sands visit, where you can sip a martini or a Singapore Sling at the Marina Bay Sands hotel, or head to any of Singapore's uber trendy neighbourhoods to browse shops featuring independent designers, swinging by a hawker stall to refuel at any given opportunity. This evening, why not choose to enjoy the city by night with a Singapore night optional experience. Visit Gardens by the Bay to watch Supertree Grove come alive with sound and light, before ending the night with a traditional 'bumboat' ride.

CHOICE OPTIONAL EXPERIENCES:

Morning Visit to Johore Bahru Malaysia - Cross the causeway linking Singapore to Malaysia and once across the border visit the city of Johore Bahru which is the largest city south of Kuala Lumpur. Visit the Royal Abu Bakar Mosque before driving along Lido Beach towards Craft Town to observe batik painting for wall pictures and sarongs. This is followed by a visit to a Malay Cemetery and the exterior of the Royal Mausoleum to learn about the Muslim traditions of burial. Proceed with a drive through the City centre before making our way back across the causeway to Singapore. Please check if you need a visa for entry into Malaysia and re-entry into Singapore. The price shown is in Singapore Dollars.

Walking Tour - Times of the Empire (Mondays only) - Singapore was claimed as a trading outpost of the British Empire and in governance, religion, and entertainment the imprint of Singapore's colonial past is indelible. On this walk discover Singapore's colonial legacy and learn about the national flower, the Sarkies brothers, The Straits Times and that wonderful drink called 'the Singapore Sling'. Walk departs from City Hall MRT Station outside Exit B and ends at Raffles Hotel. Transport to/from the start/end of the walk not included. Operates every Monday except Public Holidays. The price shown is in Singapore Dollars.

Walking Tour - Dhobis, Saris and a Spot of Curry (Tuesdays only) - On this walk discover the charms of Little India with the colourful hindu Sri Veeramakaliamman Temple, the Fruit and Vegetable Wet Market, the spice shops and the flower stalls. Learn about sari tying and henna art. It was once said that there are three ways to India from Singapore: by ship, by plane, and by a short walk to Little India! Walk departs from Little India MRT station outside Exit E (Buffalo Road) and ends at the Sri Veeramakaliamman Temple. Transport to/from the start/end of the walk not included. Operates every Tuesday except Public Holidays. The price shown is in Singapore Dollars.

Walking Tour - Red Clogs down the Five Foot Way (Wednesdays only) - Enjoy the fragrance of Chinese tea, ginseng and herbal eggs as you stroll through Chinatown. Sticky cakes, exotic fruits, sweetmeats – the streets of Chinatown are food paradise. Visit the Thian Hock Kheng Temple and the slippery wet market to check out paper cars, houses, 'handphones', and even lingerie - all part of an ancient Chinese funeral ritual. Learn about the Yins and Yangs of

Chinese traditional medicine and discover where to get those ready-made clogs and that steaming hot bun! Walk departs from Telok Ayer MRT station outside Exit A (Cross Street) and ends at Pagoda Street, close to Chinatown MRT station. Transport to/from the start/end of the walk not included. Operates every Wednesday except Public Holidays. The price shown is in Singapore Dollars.

Walking Tour - Sultans of Spice (Thursdays only) - Many people don't remember the sultans that used to rule! See the old Royal Palace, the Sultan Mosque and the Tombs of the Malayan Princes: they all carry an air of royalty snatched away too quickly. Uncover an interesting blend of Malay folk traditions and Islam in the legends of the mysterious keris (dagger), exotic perfumes and the story of the faith that is sometimes misunderstood. Don't miss this hidden cultural enclave where Singapore's indigenous culture still thrives! Walk departs from Bugis MRT station outside Exit B (side where Raffles Hospital is) and ends at Jalan Kubor. Transport to/from the start/end of the walk not included. Operates every Thursday except Public Holidays. The price shown is in Singapore Dollars.
